Amazing saga of rescuing 'Kyser' the American bulldog

The weeks from Thanksgiving to Christmas are always a magical time of love, sharing and giving, so it seems fitting that wonderful things are happening for a special "boy" in the rescue world. "Kyser" aka "Einstein" is a 2-year-old American bulldog who has not had the best of years. He was a shelter favorite, adopted and his owner returned him to the shelter eight months later. "Kyser" was in need of training and Boise Bully Breed Rescue was contacted to determine if they had interest in accepting him. The rescue gladly accepted Kyser when Rhi and Jeff, owners of Frenchie's Grooming & Boarding in Meridian, agreed to work with him.



Since residing at Frenchie's, he has mastered his basic commands, leash training and can even put himself on the treadmill and take a jog when he feels like it.

But sadly, after seven months, no foster or adoptive home surfaced that seemed a good fit for him. Boise Bully Breed Rescue would not give up on "Kyser" and petitioned Brian Campbell, Service Dog Trainer of Miracle Mutts in Sonoma, California to consider Kyser for a position as a service dog. After careful consideration, Brian agreed and a new door has opened for "Kyser." The only obstacle that remained was the logistics of transporting him from Idaho to California.

Another magical miracle occurred when BBRB Transporter Anita stepped forward and worked on the logistics for a week with Pilots N Paws and secured "Kyser's" passage to California. Today, Anita will personally transport him from Boise to Winnemucca, Nevada, where she will meet Kim, "Kyser's" pilot for the next leg of his journey. Kim and her husband, Rob, are flying their personal plane from Placerville, California to meet "Kyser." Once secured, they will fly him from Winnemucca to Santa Rosa Airport, where he will be delivered to his new guardian and service trainer, Brian.

"Kyser" is set to begin a new chapter in his life and BBRB is extremely thankful to everyone who has assisted with his progress and journey. A big thank you to Wendy and Toni, owners of A Mind's Eye Tattoo, for introducing Brian of Miracle Mutts to the rescue. Thanks also to Dr. Talitha Neher for completing his physical, health certificate and vaccinations for the transport.
